# 6. Language

The language spoken in class is Spanish and/or Catalan. In the classes where there are Erasmus students, Spanish will be used, unless the students are interested in learning Catalan too.

The school guarantees a tutor, who will oversee the incoming student's progress in both language and academic contents.

There are no Spanish and Catalan courses taught in the school, but you can attend courses here:

### 7. Housing

According to recent calculation, the total monthly living expenses for a single student in Tarrega is around 450/500 euros. This sum represents minimum living cost, which includes accommodation, food, necessary clothing, transport and school supplies. Students expecting to spend money on travel, entertainment, specific health care needs, etc. should consider accordingly larger expenses.

The school does not have a student dormitory. Most students, who are not Tarrega residents, rent apartments and rooms in the private sector. Rent for a single-room apartment with a bathroom and kitchen in Tarrega starts from 170/200 euros per month.

In some cases, the school is at the students's disposal to search a private accommodation for them. For the first couple of days and until we can help you find some definitive lodging, incoming Erasmus students can stay at these nice, affordable hotels:
